Position Description:

Penn's Youth Initiative, Inc. (PYI), a 501c3 education nonprofit resources schools and youth organizations for social and emotional wellness and risk avoidance skills through quality relationship education. By utilizing an evidence-based curriculum backed by medical research and social science, PYI aims to engage young people through dynamic, interactive presentations that are light-hearted, affirming and developmentally age-appropriate.

Primary Functions:

The Program Educator will serve in a pivotal role, working to provide PYI programming in the FAY (Franklin, Adams, & York Counties) region, delivering in-person presentations to schools and youth organizations. This individual will aid PYI by serving one county of choice, targeting high-risk populations in school districts and youth organizations. Occasional services to neighboring counties may be requested. Reliable transportation is a must.

PYI will train and mentor this individual during a probationary period of 3 months.

Job Duties:

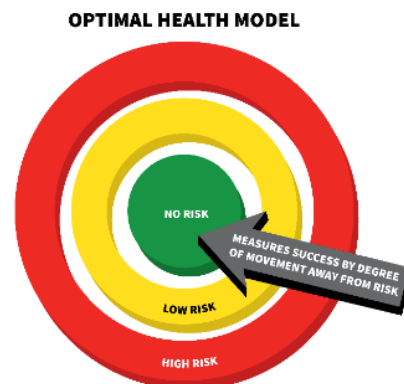
- Prepare lesson plans and deliver presentations using REAL Essentials (RE).
- Deliver PYI presentations to 5th -12th grade students in school districts, youth organizations and other at-risk youth populations.
- Foster a positive, professional presence within the community.
- Follow protocols to collect and enter performance measure data.
